Dear Herron-Riverside Families,

It is a season of celebration at Riverside! From wrapping up two weeks of AP testing today to the incredible Arts Showcase this past week to Senior Breakfast, Argonaut athletics conference competitions, Friday's movie night at Tibbs Drive-In, next week's Awards Night, a flourishing campus garden, and of course, culminating in graduation for the class of 2022 on Saturday, May 21, there are SO MANY wonderful things happening here in May! I am grateful for our thriving community and the chance to celebrate the hard work of our scholars, faculty, coaches, and families.

As your student prepares for the end of the semester, I wanted to share a few notes and reminders:

Friday, May 27th is designated as an intentional academic support and community service day for 9th-11th graders. Students with 2 or more NGs as of Monday, May 23rd, will attend academic support sessions from 10:00 AM - 2:00 PM. Students with 1 or 0 NGs will have the option of working on final exam study guides at home or coming into campus to participate in a range of community service opportunities, also from 10:00 AM - 2:00 PM. Signups for the community service options will go out next week. We will be hosting an optional Field Day celebration in the park across the street from 2:00 - 3:00 PM for any 9th-11th grader who wants to participate, or students are free to dismiss at 2:00.

Final Exams run from Tuesday, May 31 - Friday, June 3. Final exams count as 15% of your student's semester grade. Each exam testing day, including Friday June 3, will be a 9:00 AM - 12:30 PM school day following the schedule below. Monday, June 6 will be a make-up testing day for students who missed an exam due to a verified absence.

Students will pick up a lunch and leave campus after Exam 2 (except for students who qualify for extra time for testing)

Lastly, please check in with your student and review their academic progress in PowerSchool. To stay on track for graduation, students need to earn at least five credits (pass at least five classes) each semester; however, a student's GPA is an even greater predictor of post-secondary educational success. There is still time for students to use their late and remediation passes, attend Office Hours, and prepare well for their final exams so that those NGs can become Cs, Cs can become Bs, and Bs become As! Uniform Update for 2022-2023 School Year

For the 2022-2023 school year, Herron-Riverside High School will resume the requirement for uniform pants/shorts with the school logo. Pants/shorts with the updated HRHS logo or the Riverside "R" logo will be allowed. The school skort from SchoolBelles will also still be allowed for uniform bottoms

Other items of our school uniform will remain the same. Scholars must wear a plain white or navy blue polo shirt every day to school with or without a school logo, purchased from SchoolBelles or any other store. Scholars may wear outerwear that is purchased from SchoolBelles with the school logo (new or old) or a plain, navy crewneck sweatshirt without the school logo purchased from any other store. Students must wear shoes with backs and only a clear backpack is allowed to be carried throughout the school day from class to class. Please refer to the school handbook for more details.

AP Lit Field Trip to the LUME

Last Friday, May 6, Herron-Riverside's AP Literature & Composition class went on a field trip to Newfields to see the LUME exhibit. The LUME highlights Vincent Van Gogh's life and work in an immersive, digitally enhanced space set to music. It's magical. One scholar said, "I didn't know museums could be like this!"

After seeing the LUME, scholars had some time to explore the museum on their own, and then met back up to reflect on the experience and discuss the purpose of art collectively and individually. The class said that art provides a form of self-expression; that creating art is part of what makes us human; and that art can bring us together and build empathy. They talked about the power of art to refresh us and restore our hope.

AP Lit teacher Diana Allen said, "Teaching this class was special. It was an honor for me, their teacher, to watch them experience the art that has made me."
