Christopher Musto thanked the Bergen County Executive, Bergen County Department of Health, Police Chief James O'Connor and Commissioner John Montillo.

Tracey L. Marinelli read the following Opening Statement regarding Ebola:

There have been concern expressed by parents and community members regarding a rumor linking a potential case of Ebola to our district. We want you to know that we take any potential

health threat to our district very seriously and work vigorously and proactively to do all that we can to ensure the well being of our students and employees.

There are no students enrolled in our schools who, to the very best of our knowledge, have been exposed to, or who have contracted, the Ebola virus. Please be aware that we are in strict compliance with the guidelines established by the Center for Disease Control, the New Jersey Department of Health, Bergen County Department of Health, and local health officials. Specifically, we have taken the following actions:

- We have trained our Registrar to implement the "Ebola Risk Assessment Tool" for all registering students, not only those with potential exposure. A copy of this assessment is posted on our website along with procedures we will follow based upon the assessment.
- We have conducted meetings and telephone conversations with key stakeholders including our Chief of Police, Commissioner of Public Safety, Supervisor of Health and Nursing, Board Attorney, Board President, School Administration, local and county health departments, and the CDC.
- We have met with our Crisis Management Team to review policies and procedures related to health threats.
- We have met with our Nursing Department to ensure that we have the necessary health protocols and equipment in place.
- We have met with our Director of Maintenance and Grounds to institute additional disinfecting procedures above and beyond our thorough daily cleanings.
- We have posted the following information to our website:
 - "What You Need to Know About Ebola" (a newsletter from the CDC)
 - "The Ebola Virus Disease Risk Assessment Tool" (currently being used by our Registrar) and "Ebola Virus Disease Interim Guidance" both of which have been provided by the New Jersey Department of Health, Communicable Disease Service.

As any additional information and resources from federal, state and local health experts comes to our attention, we will continue to adhere to all recommended procedures and we will keep you informed via our website and email blasts. As your Superintendent of Schools, and on behalf of our Board of Education, I assure you that the safety and emotional, mental, and physical health of our children and staff remains our top priority.

There have been concern expressed by parents and community members regarding a rumor linking a potential case of Ebola to our district. We want you to know that we take any potential health threat to our district very seriously and work vigorously and proactively to do all that we can to ensure the well being of our students and employees.

There are no students enrolled in our schools who, to the very best of our knowledge, have been exposed to, or who have contracted, the Ebola virus. Please be aware that we are in strict compliance with the guidelines established by the Center for Disease Control, the New Jersey

Department of Health, Bergen County Department of Health, and local health officials. Specifically, we have taken the following actions:

- We have trained our Registrar to implement the "Ebola Risk Assessment Tool" for all registering students, not only those with potential exposure. A copy of this assessment is posted on our website along with procedures we will follow based upon the assessment.
- We have conducted meetings and telephone conversations with key stakeholders including our Chief of Police, Commissioner of Public Safety, Supervisor of Health and Nursing, Board Attorney, Board President, School Administration, local and county health departments, and the CDC.
- We have met with our Crisis Management Team to review policies and procedures related to health threats.
- We have met with our Nursing Department to ensure that we have the necessary health protocols and equipment in place.
- We have met with our Director of Maintenance and Grounds to institute additional disinfecting procedures above and beyond our thorough daily cleanings.
- We have posted the following information to our website:
 - "What You Need to Know About Ebola" (a newsletter from the CDC)
 - "The Ebola Virus Disease Risk Assessment Tool" (currently being used by our Registrar) and "Ebola Virus Disease Interim Guidance" both of which have been provided by the New Jersey Department of Health, Communicable Disease Service.

As any additional information and resources from federal, state and local health experts comes to our attention, we will continue to adhere to all recommended procedures and we will keep you informed via our website and email blasts. As your Superintendent of Schools, and on behalf of our Board of Education, I assure you that the safety and emotional, mental, and physical health of our children and staff remains our top priority.
