Bachelor's degree in Early Childhood Education, Elementary Education or related field required. Montessori experience, training or certification preferred. Candidates must have at least two years of relevant classroom teaching experience. Full-time position, 10 month employee.

Instructional Assistant: CLA seeks full-time early childhood instructional assistants for the 2022-23 school year. The positions will serve in a preprimary Montessori classroom serving students from 3 to 5 years old and a Kindergarten classroom. The ideal candidate has prior classroom experience and education in early childhood education. Experience in a Montessori learning environment is preferred. *Full-time position, 10 month employee.*

Early Childhood Spanish Teacher: CLA seeks an early childhood Spanish teacher for the 2022-23 school year. The position will serve in preprimary and lower school alongside lower school and middle school Spanish teachers, serving students in grades 3 years old - second grade. The ideal candidate has prior teaching experience and has previously worked in preschool. Candidates should be fluent in Spanish, have a degree in early childhood education or related

field and a minimum of two years in a teaching environment. *Full-time position, 10 month employee.*

Candidates should have a degree in Physical Education or related field and a minimum of two years in a teaching environment. *Full-time position, 10 month employee.*

Upper Elementary / Middle School Math Teacher - Creative Learning Academy is seeking an Upper Elementary & Middle School Math Teacher for the 2022-23 school year. This individual will teach 5th and 6th grade math and serve as an integral part of curriculum design, student support and enrichment at all grade levels. Candidates should have a degree in Elementary Education, Math Education or related field and a minimum of two years in a classroom environment. *Full-time position, 10 month employee. Part-time may be considered.*

After School Program Counselor: Seeking energetic and committed staff for our 2022-23 after school program to coordinate and implement age-appropriate activities for students. This is a part time position, work hours are 2:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. on regularly-scheduled school days. Essential duties include, but not limited to, engaging students in enrichment activities, games, snack and homework support. Responsibilities include maintaining attendance, ensuring daily safety of children, and effective classroom management skills. Secure building and equipment.
