ECFE classes include:

PARENT AND CHILD TIME

Activities where parents and children enjoy time together in a group along with a teacher or parent educator.

Families will develop friendships with others in the community and engage in learning together.

CHILDREN'S DISCOVERY TIME

Time for children to play with one another and a teacher while parents are in parent time.

Children will develop and learn physical, language, literacy, social and emotional skills.

PARENT TIME

Parent education time with other parents and a parent educator in a supportive group setting during children's discovery time.

Parents will:

- Celebrate accomplishments and problem solve challenges.
- Explore intentional parenting: short and long-term goals for their family.
- Discuss strategies for guiding children as they develop, etc.

All are welcome. The word "parent" is used in our EC&FE program. Parent also includes other adult(s) important in a child's life that participate in our program (i.e., aunt, caregiver, foster parent, grandparent, guardian, nanny, step-parent, uncle).

FREE EC&FE classes for parents and infants

Registration is based on age of the infant at the start of the class.

What to expect in an infant class

Come to interact with your baby in a space designed especially for infants and meet other families with infants in the community. You will learn fun play ideas, songs to sing and gain information and support for parenting your baby. Discussion time will be focused on parenting an infant. Topics typically include: sleep, feeding, establishing routines, adjusting to family life, developmental milestones and more! Infant classes are non-separating classes. Families stay together for the entire class time in a group. Sibling care is available unless listed otherwise.

Infant Massage

For parents with infants birth to 9 months.

Learn how to understand and respond to your baby's cues and signals as you deepen your bond through the relaxing practice of massage.

Participants will also learn:

- Practices for better infant sleep and digestion.
- Ways to increase infant brain and nervous system development.
- How to deepen your baby's sense of safety and attachment to caregivers.

This class will be taught by an instructor certified through the International Institute of Infant Massage. Classes that meet one time will give a general overview. Classes that meet two times will go more in-depth and provide opportunities for you to practice and reflect on strategies learned.

Welcome Baby

For parents with newborns from birth to 12 weeks.

A public health nurse and parent educator will be available to provide information and support. Class will begin with an opportunity to weigh and measure your newborn to track growth and will include:

- Time to meet other parents in the community with newborns.
- Learn activities to do at home with your baby.
- Time to talk about sleep, attachment, development, perinatal mental health and other topics related to parenting a newborn

Come every week or as often as you can!

Arbor View was the first place my daughter got to interact with others as a baby. It was an important part of my getting to know about parenting in America.

Baby and Me

For expectant parents and parents with infants birth to 12 months.

This one-time class is in partnership with HUG (Helping Us Grow) with a focus on introducing early literacy skills. Each family will leave with a copy of the book *Brain Games for Babies* and a set of board books to take home.

Parents will:

- Connect with other parents in the community that are also expecting or have a new baby and a parent educator.
- Learn sample activities to do at home with your baby based on the book *Brain Games for Babies*.

Food and water will be provided.

No sibling care is available.



ECFE classes for parents and children 1-2

For children one or older by September 1, 2022.

What to expect in a class

Your 1-2 year-old child is experiencing a time of rapid growth and development. These classes are designed for you and your child to discover new learning in a space your child can safely explore and move. Discussion time will be focused on parenting 1-2 year olds and the interests of the group. Topics typically include: safety, language development, nutrition, separation and more! Parent and child separating time will be determined by the needs of the group. Sibling care is available unless listed otherwise.

Discussion topics will be focused on parenting 2-3 year olds and the interests of the group. Topics typically include: setting limits, toilet learning, social-emotional development, play ideas and more! Parent and child separating time will be determined by the needs of the group. Sibling care is available.

What to expect in a family class?

Discussion topics will be focused on parenting children from birth to five years old and the interests of the group. Topics may include developmental milestones, positive guidance, sibling relationships, use of media and more! There is no charge for infants birth to 12 months to attend a class for children birth to five. Infants birth to 5 months old attend parent group with their adult. Parent and child separation time will be determined by the needs of the group. There is no sibling care available.

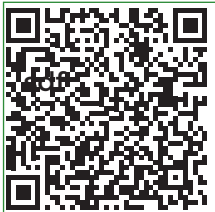
For parents and children birth to five

Registration Lottery

June 10, 2022

Once your registration is complete it will be "waiting for lottery".

Registrations completed by 10 a.m. on June 10, 2022 will be entered in the random lottery drawing.

After the lottery, registrations will be accepted first-come, first-served until classes are filled. Space is limited in our program.

Cancellation

Classes may be canceled by the program due to lack of enrollment. Effort will be made by the program to help participants select another class or provide a full refund.

Fees

Fees will not be processed until the day of the lottery June 10, 2022. Charges will appear as *Osseo Area Schools*.

If participants register for a course after the lottery date, fees will be charged at the time of registration.

Refunds

Full refunds will be provided if cancellation occurs before class begins. After a class begins refunds will be pro-rated based on the weeks remaining of the class. To cancel a registration contact the program office at 763-391-8777.

No one will be denied participation due to inability to pay.

There is a one-time fee for a class. To determine the fee find your household annual gross income and the number of weeks on the chart below. Example: 14-101A is a 14 week class. If your household annual gross income is \$50,000 the class fee would be \$121. If you need sibling care for another child during this class the sibling care fee would be \$39. No proof of income is required.
