GROUP SWIM LESSONS

On the first day please arrive 15 minutes early to check in. Please bring a towel and slip-on shoes/sandals. Your child must come dressed to swim and have sunscreen applied.

No make-up lessons or refunds for missed days due to unavoidable biological accidents or acts of nature.

Our lessons are split into two age groups: Little Fish Swimmers (ages 3-5) and Jr. Swimmers (ages 6-12). Each group has two levels beginning & intermediate. See more details below.

Please register your child for the level below that best fits their ability. We will evaluate the swimmers on the first day of class and may regroup them according to skill level.



SWIM LEVELS

Little Fish Swimmers (Ages 3-5)

Level 1 (Beginning): Children with little or no swimming experience. Skills taught: water entry, floats, kicking, glides, arm action on front & back, intro to side breathing and water safety.

Level 2 (Intermediate): Children must have basic skill; floating, kicking, comfortable swimming unassisted for 5-10 yards with arm action. Skills taught: freestyle with side breathing, backstroke, and intro to breaststroke & butterfly.

Jr. Swimmers (Ages 6-12)

Level 1 (Beginning): Children with minimal swimming experience. Skills taught: water entry, floats, kicking, glides, arm action on front & back, intro to side breathing and water safety.

Level 2 (Intermediate): Children must have basic skill; floating, kicking, comfortable swimming unassisted for 5-10 yards with arm action. Skills taught: freestyle with side breathing, backstroke, and intro to breaststroke & butterfly.

*For children at a more advanced level looking to develop stroke technique and endurance we recommend our Swim Camp.

PRIVATE SWIM LESSONS - Event# 12099

Private lessons are limited and offered for thirty (30) minute intervals, one-to-one or for up to two participants per lesson. The person requesting the private lessons is responsible for finding the additional participant. Classes are designed around the swimmers ability. Space is limited and the same instructor may not be available. Lesson times and days will be arranged directly with the instructor. Classes will be scheduled between 1:00p-3:00p.

INTERMEDIATE/ADVANCED SWIM CAMP (AGES 5-13)

This camp will focus on the development of the 4 fundamentals strokes (freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke & butterfly).

Additional skills taught include flip-turns, diving, racing starts and finishes. All swimmers need to be able to swim 25 yards unassisted and have a basic understanding of the 4 fundamental strokes. Please bring goggles and those with long hair tie it back or use a swim cap.
