Who is eligible for Teacher Exchange Days

Teachers on a 187 Day Contract who complete the requirements outlined in the following sections.

Qualifying for a Teacher Exchange Day

In order to qualify for both Teacher Exchange Days, a teacher must complete two of the following between June 1, 2022 and July 26, 2022:

- Complete assigned Public School Works Online Training courses;
- Attend a full day workshop at CISD, Region 4, Region 6, or other pre approved vendors;
- Attend two (2) half day workshops at CISD, Region 4, Region 6, or other pre approved vendors.

*These trainings may be online or face to face.

Out of District Workshops

Workshops must be pre approved by the campus principal in order to qualify for the Teacher Exchange Day.

Providing Documentation

All CISD Workshops will be created in Strive and teachers can enroll in the courses by logging into their Eduphoria account. All outside Professional Development workshops must be manually entered into strive by the teacher and the certificate uploaded into the account.
