We hope this letter finds you safe and well. This letter is to inform you of the Keystone Exam testing requirements that will impact students who are currently enrolled in a Keystone trigger course (English 10, Biology and Algebra 1) during the Fall 2021 semester. Students enrolled in a Keystone trigger course complete the exam toward the end of their course enrollment.

**The initial window for testing is January 3-14, 2022.** At this time, the Department of Education has not made any provisions for remote testing, so all students will need to attend in-person testing sessions.

\*Virtual Academy students will report to the guidance office on their assigned testing days to receive their testing location. Virtual Academy students can arrange to be picked up after their testing session has ended for the day or remain at school and work in the cyber room.
