Curriculum Map – Year 2

Literacy

Fiction: The children will learn about a traditional tale from a different culture. They will study 'The Jungle book' and create their own version. Expanded noun phrases, coordinating conjunctions and different sentence starters will be the grammar focus.

Non-Fiction: The children will learn how to write instructions and use imperative verbs.

Poetry: The children will write acrostic poems about the Jungle.

Mathematics

Multiplication: the children will learn to recognise equal groups, make equal groups, add equal groups and write multiplication sentences using 'x'. They will use arrays, make doubles and learn their 2,5 and 10 times tables.

Division: The children will learn to divide by 2, 5 and 10. They will also learn about odd and even numbers.

Statistics: They will learn about tally charts, pictograms and how to interpret data from

Science

The children will learn about living things and their habitats. They will explore the different habitats and the animals that live within them, discovering the seven life processes they need to survive.

They will discover the adaptations of animals and how they depend on each other to survive. Food chains will be an important focus as and they will also learn to identify and name different sources of food.

Art/DT

The children will look at different patterns, learn to create rubbings using media and learn about the craft of weaving.

Humanities

The children will focus on three main places: Anambra, Liverpool and Brazil. They will identify features of the places.

Nigerian Studies

The children will discover the importance of food, identify local food in Anambra, look at useful farm, insects and those that are harmful. They will also learn how to keep the environment clean and discuss features of a traditional home.

French

The children will be taught how to say their names and ask people their names in French.

They will learn about parts of the body and learn the months of the year.

Computing

The children will revisit the computer and its uses classifying the different parts into hardware and software. They will also look at word processing, e-safety internet use and how to create media digitally with photographs.

Music

The children will learn about rhythm and pitch, looking at how soft and loud, as well as fast and slow they can play using a variety of musical instruments.

They will learn about different bars and look at a variety of music composer's work.

PE

This term they will focus on practicing how to run effectively, how to exchange a baton and how to compete in an obstacle race. They will learn how to jump and land safely.
