STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

Goal: To meet or exceed all learning targets for student achievement on the 2019 MCAS.

Focus Areas:

1. Research Next Gen MCAS components (webinars and workshops) in preparation for implementation in Spring 2019
2. Facilitate MCAS practice questions with all students
3. Ensure all students are taught state standards and instructional coaching is tied to the standards
4. Implement semester-based Math Lab and Bio Blast class aligned to high value standards
5. Implement Edulastics benchmarking system in targeted Math, ELA, and Science classes and monitor progress on benchmark standards

RIGOROUS COURSEWORK

Goal: To continue to expand access to rigorous coursework and improve qualifying scores for all students on their respective AP exams.

Focus Areas:

1. Create and implement an AP Action Plan designed to increase access to AP courses while increasing qualifying scores
2. Offer AP teacher training regarding new resources available from College Board
3. Meet targets set by the state for advanced coursework completion

PBIS

Goal: By June 2019, Wahconah will move from an exploration to an implementation phase to support school-wide Positive Behavior Intervention Supports (PBIS).

Focus Areas:

1. Conduct Implementation training for whole staff
2. Plan and implement school-wide celebration of core values with reinforcement activities in homeroom
3. Create a school-wide student expectations matrix
4. Create a PBIS Leadership Team

SOCIAL/EMOTIONAL/SAFETY

Goal: To implement a relocation and parent reunification plan including facilitation of an off-site drill.

Focus Areas:

1. Consult with MSP and DPD regarding implementation of a parent reunification plan
2. Conduct a site visit of the Stationery Factory
3. Conduct school-wide evacuation, relocation, and reunification drill (off site)
4. Debrief evacuation, relocation, and reunification drill with staff
5. Select staff receive trauma training
6. Select staff receive ADL "World of Difference" Training
7. Meet targets for graduation rate and chronic absenteeism
