See you in August!



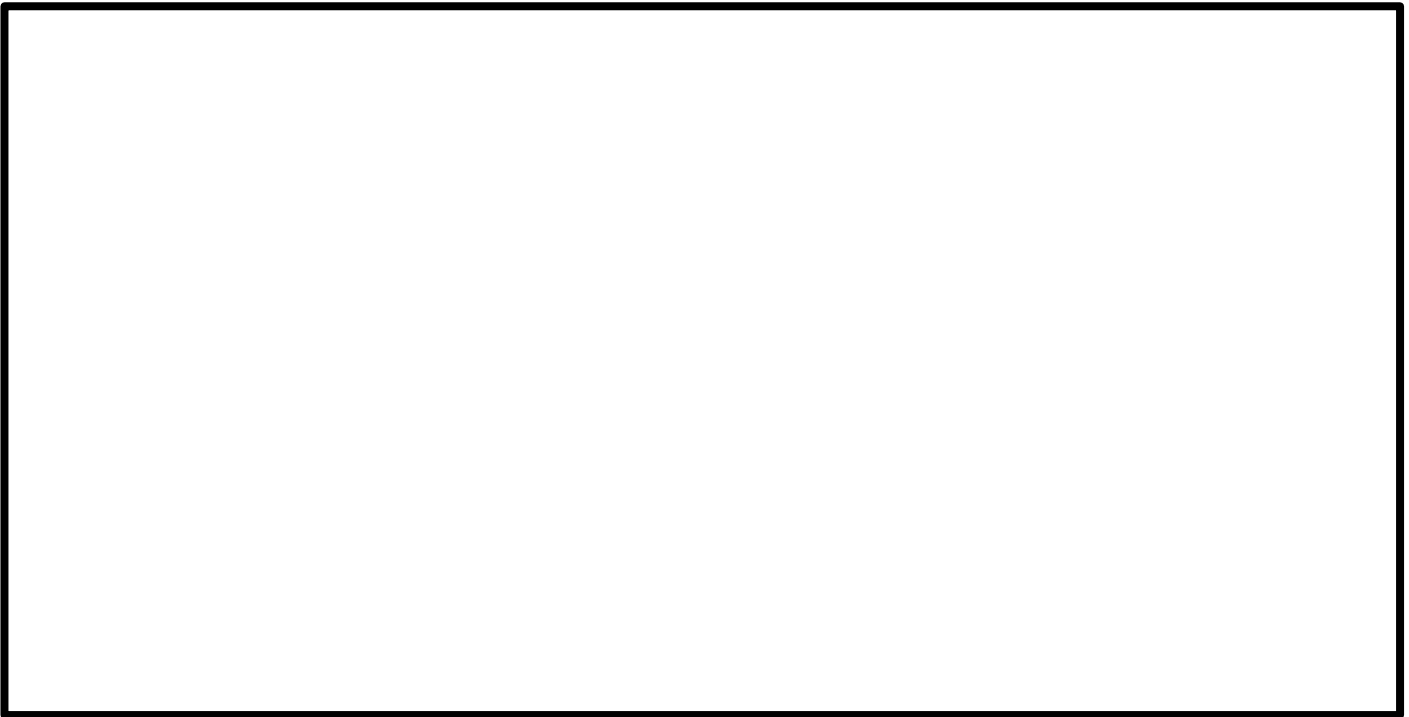
The Tree

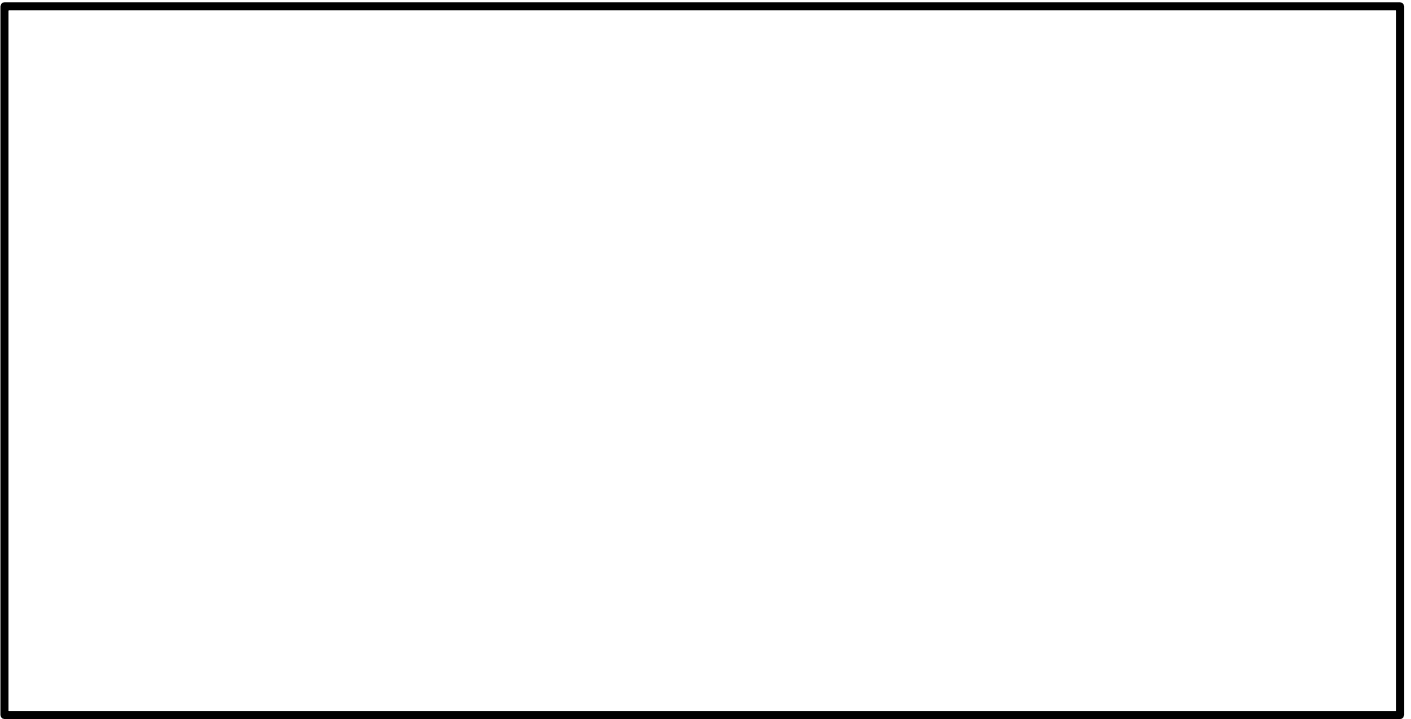
