Dear Third Graders,

Welcome to Third Grade! We are excited to begin a new year with you at the end of the summer.

During the summer months we ask that you keep an active mind. You will be expected to complete assignments in three areas: reading, writing, and math.

Reading: You will need to read over the summer. We are not requiring a specific book; however, we ask that you read often and read many different types of books. Picture books, chapter books, graphic novels, magazines, and/or the newspaper are a few suggestions. Expand your horizons! Read silently. Read aloud to your family. Listen to someone read aloud to you. Listen to audiobooks. Record your reading in your summer reading log.

Writing: Write in your Summer Journal over the summer. Write about interesting things you are doing, places you are visiting, or everyday things you are doing at home. Complete one page of journaling each week on the pages provided. There is space provided for you to draw a picture.

Math: We ask that you spend time over the summer reviewing math computation. For example, you could practice math facts, solve multi-digit problems, and/or play math games. Practicing math several times a week over the summer will keep your skills fresh.

Please use most of your summertime to have fun. Just set aside some time to practice your school skills. You might even find that you enjoy doing them!

We ask you to bring in five items that tell about you on the first day of school. This is a chance for all of us to get to know each other.

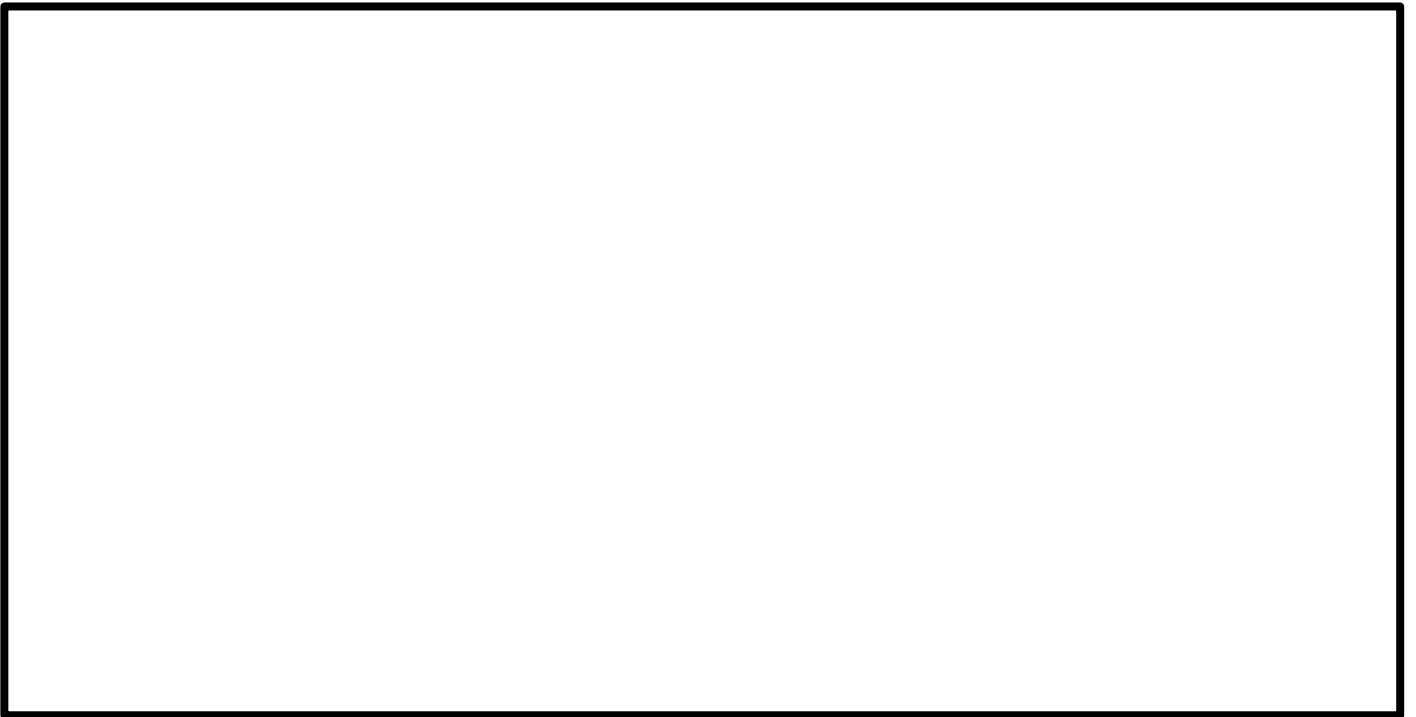
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
