New Memorial Drive Elementary School – Project Scope

- Replacement of Memorial Drive Elementary School with new building and site elements
- Approx. 88,000 SF building per SBISD Educational Specifications
- Off Site Transition: Campus will relocate to South Transition Campus from January 2023 thru May 2024
- 18-20 months total construction period
- August 2024 = New MDE opens



PAT Engagement – Project Advisory Team (PAT) Charge

OVERVIEW

A Project Advisory Team (PAT) will be chartered for the planning of a replacement for **Memorial Drive Elementary School** under the school's project in the 2017 Bond Program.

CHARGE

The PAT will work collaboratively and cooperatively with the architect and SBISD Project Manager to conceptualize, develop and refine the project's goals and design.


The PAT will <u>advise on recommendations</u> regarding the interior and exterior appearance of the replacement of Memorial Drive Elementary School.

The PAT will reach a proposed recommendation through consensus.

These <u>recommendations will be presented</u> to the <u>Superintendent</u> + <u>Board of Trustees for approval</u>. The Board of Trustees may act upon the recommendations developed with PAT input by approving, amending, altering or not approving all or any part of the recommendations.

Areas of focus from which the <u>PAT should refrain include</u> recommendations regarding school programs, policies and procedures, boundaries of district facilities, instructional arrangements and/or educational pedagogy decided upon and/or subject to District, State and Federal laws.







Building Shape / Forms + Exterior Finish Materials <u>communicate</u> <u>the proposed exterior expression</u> of the new Memorial Drive ES design:

- Balanced geometric forms are expressed through a limited range of natural materials in a neutral palette.
- Masonry colors allow the building to blend into the naturally wooded campus.
- Material patterns and texture help provide depth and dimensional details to the composition.
- Wood tone under the canopy overhangs with the slender columns create a warm, inviting welcome
 with a natural and approachable composition
- Use of glass provides views and reflects the natural sky and vegetation of the MDE campus.








What Do You Like the Most?

- Interior / Exterior Connection
- Natural Elements lend a calming effect
- Color & Contrast are more fun for kids
- Tones / Contrast = Gives it a Special Feel
- Medium contrast gives color but isn't too loud
- Mostly neutral with pops of color
- Fun but not overwhelming, Simplicity

- Vibrant is over stimulating, too busy, distracting
- No contrast is not interesting
- Windows in Library with Lots of Lines
- Color wash is too institutional
- Saturated / Low Contrast








What Do You Like the Most?

- Elements that mimic nature
- Different shapes from nature / Fluidity
- Advanced geometries seem more fun and engaging
- Angular / Curvilinear feels soothing and organic
- Organic / Curvilinear creates interest, less monotony
- Organic features bring in natural forms
- Simplicity with some variations and surprises
- Balanced, large-scale for high ceilings

- Don't like Sterile
- Too many rectangles are too boxy
- Mixed scale everywhere
- Curves can waste space
- Large scale too overwhelming
- Stairs do not want tripping hazard









What Do You Like the Most?

- Natural & Random Interplay of Wood and Glass
- Linear + Random Feels like In a Forest
- Linear + Random Multicolor & Texture
- Linear + Random Offers opportunity for variation
- Clean, predictable, balanced lines + added color
- Simplicity with some variations
- Pops of Shape and Color, but not too modern
- Blended image is beautiful, calming, welcoming

- Predictability and Monotony
- Bright Colors + Hard Shapes / Lines
- Colors = Too many / Too bright
- Rectangles = Only / Too many







What Do You Like the Most?

- Wood / Stone with other materials for Pop / Texture
- Wood + Carpet/Textiles + Acoustic design elements
- Connect = Exterior materials + Interior textiles, color
- Common Areas = Textiles Softer pops of color
- Classroom = Soothing, Calming
- Variation, variation

- Floors High polished, Institutional looking
- Don't feel too cold, sterile, hard
- Too much color / Too vibrant
- Bright, busy walls and floors
- Primary colors
- Fluorescent lighting


Memorial Drive ES Design

The proposed <u>interior design concepts</u> being recommended has been developed <u>based on feedback and direction set</u> by PAT Committee Mtgs #1 thru Mtg #5:

- Reflecting the wooded site and the trees featured at the entry and courtyard, the new MDE school interior design draws inspiration from the geometries and patterns found in nature.
- The palette echoes colors found in the sun, water, plants and minerals.
- Biophilic design, mimicking the natural environment, has been shown to support student success.



PAT Mtg#6: Design Progress | Interior Expression – Textures and Patterns









- **Textures and patterns** found in **nature** soften the geometry of the built environment.
- A variety of textures creates visual interest and is fun for PK/K-5th grade students.
- Smaller **scale** elements are **inviting and encourage exploration**.








