Marching practices will be held in the Auditorium or Alumni Gym, please be on time!

GENERAL INFORMATION: You can dress casually but appropriate for school. We will be practicing and getting ready for: Senior Awards Night, Final Assembly, and Commencement – all in different locations.

WHEN:

**Monday, June 6: 1:15 – 2:25 PM – AUDITORIUM** – we will practice marching in and out of the AUD (needed for Tuesday evening). Also, Yearbook dedication, Yearbook begins distribution to Seniors, Caps and Gowns distributed, Baccalaureate tickets distributed – Please remember that you cannot receive your cap and gown until your obligations have been met.

**Tuesday, June 7: 1:15 – 2:25 PM – AUDITORIUM** – We will rehearse marching in and out of the AUD, we will rehearse names being announced at Graduation. Also, Project Graduation information/presentation

**Wednesday, June 8: 11:30 – 1:00 PM – ALUMNI GYM** – We will rehearse marching in and out of ALUMNI, which will mimic the plan for the CIA. Also, we will practice receiving your diploma with the Board Chair and the Superintendent so you know how that works and we will practice the names as they are to be read at graduation again. Mr. LeGage will review the plan for Sunday, June 12. Lastly, we will rehearse for the Final Assembly at 9:00 AM on Thursday morning.

**Thursday, June 9: approx. 10:30 AM – 12:00 Noon – ALUMNI GYM** – Following the Senior Stroll, students should put their cap and gown in their vehicle for safety or somewhere safe in the school if you don't have a car onsite. We will do a complete run through of the graduation ceremony with marching and a final review of the names and go over every step of commencement as

one final run through. Also, Graduation tickets will be distributed after practice is done. Students will not receive these tickets until obligations have been met.

### **FINAL ASSEMBLY AND SENIOR STROLL**

WHEN: Thursday, June 9, 2022 – School Assembly at 9:00 AM, students and staff only; the Senior Stroll (weather permitting) will be held at Memorial Park at 9:45 AM. K-8 students and parents/families are invited to attend the stroll! These two events are “cap and gown” events with casual attire beneath.

COVID RULES: Assembly will follow SHS building rules at the time. The Stroll is held outside and therefore no masks are required. Again, more specifics will go out closer to the event if needed.

### **COMMENCEMENT**

WHEN: Sunday, June 12, 2022, 7:00 PM

WHERE: Cross Insurance Arena, Portland, ME (formally the Civic Center)

ATTIRE: Seniors – Caps and Gowns with semi-formal attire underneath (including footwear)

COVID RULES: We will be following the Cross Insurance Arena protocols for this event – more information closer to the event

GENERAL INFORMATION: Seniors will have a bottle of water placed beneath their seat. There will be a photographer in front of the stage to capture a picture of each graduate receiving their diploma. The ceremony will be live-streamed for family and friends who are not able to attend graduation. There will be information sent close to June 12<sup>th</sup> with the instructions on how to connect with the live-streaming. This is a ticketed event, no one will be admitted into the CIA without a ticket. The doors open at 6:00 PM and it is general admission. Students will be seated on the floor and there will be a smaller stage at one end of the arena. This setup is similar to last year.

Graduates will exit the arena and move directly to the buses. The meet and greet will be held at the SHS parking lot. Please meet the buses in the main lot at SHS for hugs and pictures. The Project Graduation buses will leave from the High School following the meet and greet!
