



High School Level Transition Services

The IEP must include documentation (examples below) of the types of transition services the student is receiving in high school. Transition services/supports are an IEP Team decision.

Examples may include, but are not limited to:

- Accommodations
- Agency referrals
- Assistance with college enrollment
- Assistance with postsecondary goal attainment
- Community based instruction
- Instruction in daily living skills
- On-campus job experiences/internships
- School based enterprise
- Self-determination and/or self-advocacy
- Social skills training
- Transportation services
- Volunteer activities
- Career and Technical Education classes
- Learning Strategies classes
- Support Facilitation
- Remediation Courses to meet graduation requirements
- Scholar Diploma Designation courses
- Merit Diploma Designation courses
