General Spectator Guidelines

- We are excited to welcome back spectators to our outdoor events beginning with our March/April "fall" season
- For events in the stadium, we are able to accommodate up to 750 spectators. Priority will be given to parents and guardians of participants
- For events in the gym, parents or guardians of each player (or family) will have an opportunity to purchase two tickets
- All persons attending must arrange for timely transportation at the conclusion of the event. Failure to arrange for this transportation may result in denial of admission to future events
- An adult must accompany any non-high school students attending events

Governor's Order as it affects spectators at outdoor sporting events:

- i. All individuals shall adhere to the face covering and social distancing requirements, unless in the act of consuming food and beverage, in the Order of the Governor No. 20-11-17-01 (as it may be amended thereafter) (the "Executive Order");
- ii. As used herein, the term "spectator" means a person at a sports facility who is not (a) at the facility for the purpose of engaging in sporting or other customary operations, or (b) a member of the media;
- iii. All spectators shall go to their seats and remain seated, to the extent possible. At the end of the sporting event, all spectators shall exit the venue directly. Note: Spectators may certainly stand so long as they do not leave their seats.
 - Everyone must wear a mask
 - Everyone must leave when the event is over

Ticketed Events (Football, Soccer, Volleyball)

- Tickets for paid events (football, soccer, and volleyball) will be sold online through the GoFan/Huddle Ticket mobile platform
- All tickets will be \$5 (+\$1 service charge)
- Links that are private to each school and each event for purchasing tickets will be sent from the participating schools' athletic directors or coaches
- After parents and guardians have had an opportunity to purchase, the remaining tickets will be made available to the public (for stadium events)
- Two tickets per student or family will be available for purchase for volleyball matches
- Parents who are CCPS staff members will still be entitled to complimentary admission
- Spectators will present their phones upon entrance and validate their tickets

Non-Ticketed Events (Cross Country, Field Hockey, Golf)

• For our non-ticketed events (cross country, field hockey, and golf), each student will be issued two access badges on lanyards to attend these events

• Events in the gyms (volleyball, cheer competitions), and in the stadium (football, soccer) will be broadcast through the NFHS Network
