Grab a book, ruffle some fur, and read to a dog. Practice reading out loud to a certified therapy dog.



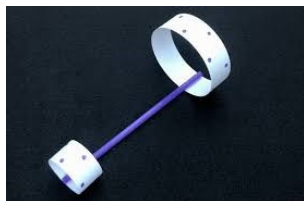
