NEW LAUNCH – A new Regional Virtual Senior Center launched earlier this month. When senior centers throughout the region closed due to the COVID-19 pandemic, staff became concerned about the danger isolation posed to the mental and physical health of older adults. To help minimize those feelings, senior centers pivoted from in-person to virtual programming so that participants could stay connected while remaining physically distant.

Although centers are now open and in-person programs have resumed, the need for virtual programming continues, both for those who cannot leave their homes as well as those who are no longer comfortable visiting centers in person. To address this ongoing need, five jurisdictions in Northern Virginia are partnering to offer a regional virtual senior center for older adults and adults with disabilities. The Northern Virginia Virtual Center for active Adults launched on May 2 to coincide with Older Americans Month. The five jurisdictions – ARLINGTON County, Fairfax City, Fairfax County, Prince William County, and the Town of Vienna – will work together to offer live virtual programming on Zoom five days a week. The events will range from fitness classes to special presentations on interactive games.

There is no fee to participate in these programs. All older adults and adults with disabilities living in Northern Virginia are welcome! Visit the NOVA VCAA by going to Fairfaxcounty.gov and searching for Northern Virginia Virtual Center for Active Adults".

AFTER FILING TAXES, WHAT RECORDS CAN YOU KEEP? — If you filed your 2021 tax return, you may want to do some spring cleaning, starting with tax-related paper clutter. Paring down is good. Just be careful to hold on to essential records that may be needed in the event of an IRS audit. Some documents may be needed to help you collect a future refund to assist with filing your return next year. Before you start tossing or shredding documents, read the rules to learn about what to keep (and for how long) and what can be safely discarded.

The general rules: At a minimum, you should keep tax records for as long as the IRS can audit your tax return or assess additional taxes. That's usually three years after you file your return. This means you potentially can get rid of most records related to tax returns for 2018 and earlier years. However, the statute of limitations extends to six years for taxpayers who understate their adjusted gross

income by more than 25%; what constitutes an understatement may go beyond simply not reporting items of income. So, to be safe, a general rule of thumb is to save tax records for six years from filing.

Keep some records longer: 1 - You need to hang on to some tax-related records beyond the statute of limitations. For example: Keep the tax returns themselves indefinitely, so you can prove to the IRS that you did file a legitimate return. If you don't file a return or if you filed a fraudulent return, there's no statute of limitations.) 2 - Retain W-2 forms until you begin receiving Social Security Benefits. That may seem long, but if questions arise regarding your work record or earnings for a particular year, you'll need your W-2 forms to help provide the documentation needed. 3 - Keep records related to real estate or investments for as long as you own the assets, plus at least three years after you sell them, and report the sales on your tax return for six years (if you want extra protection.) 4 - Hang on to receipts associated with retirement accounts until you've depleted the accounts and reported the last withdrawal on your tax return, plus three (or six) years.

Other reasons to retain records: Keep in mind that these are the federal tax record retention guidelines. Your state and local tax records may differ. In addition, lenders, co-op boards, and other private parties may require you to produce copies of your tax returns as a condition of lending money, approving a purchase, or otherwise doing business with you. BE PREPARED – For us, the hurricane season begins on June 1 and doesn't end until November 30. That's a long time! If you haven't done it, sign up for Fairfax Alerts and have a battery-powered radio available. Make sure you have proper insurance and inventory your personal property ahead of time. During a hurricane, listen to radio and TV for official, up-to-date information and stay in a safe interior room in your home. Once the storm is over, don't walk or drive through floodwaters. It just takes a little common sense to keep safe during the fickle hurricane season here in the Eastern Seaboard area.


