**Alameda, California — December 4, 2020** — The Alameda County Registrar of Voters certified the results from the November 3 election this week. The results confirm that the Board of Education candidates who won the election are Heather Little, Megan Sweet, and incumbent Jennifer Williams.

The candidates will be sworn in at the Board of Education's public meeting on December 15. At that meeting, the Board will also vote on board member positions (i.e., president, vice president, and clerk) and determine assignments to board committees and non-AUSD committees.

The last meeting for outgoing Board Members Ardella Dailey and Gray Harris will be December 9. The AUSD community is deeply grateful for the service and dedication of these outgoing Board members.

"I would like to thank Ms. Little, Ms. Sweet, and Ms. Williams for their willingness and eagerness to serve our students, our staff, our families, and our district," says Superintendent Pasquale Scuderi. "Being a board member is an important and often complex job even in the best of times. To step into this position this year, in particular, takes both courage and dedication."

Adds Board President Mia Bonta, "I am looking forward to working with our two new board members, Heather Little and Megan Sweet, as well as our returning board member, Jennifer Williams. This is a challenging time and also an exciting one, as we continue our work on the Strategic Plan, center equity in our work as a district, and focus on supporting our most vulnerable learners, particularly as we wrestle with the impacts of COVID, seek to proactively address some of the longstanding inequities in our city, and seek to support every student in Alameda during these trying times. I am eager to collaborate and govern alongside this talented and committed group of board members."
