







WHAT DOES INSTRUCTION LOOK LIKE FOR MY CHILD?

- Most instruction will be asynchronous lessons will be released on Saturday Mornings and due by midnight on Friday.
- Lessons will include videoed instruction, practice sets, assignments, and assessments.
- Most courses will be delivered through Canvas Learning Management System.





HOW IS THIS DIFFERENT FOR MY 2ND – 5TH GRADER?

 Students may have small group zoom meetings for reading groups or math groups.





WHAT DOES CURRICULUM LOOK LIKE FOR MY CHILD?

- TN State Standards alignment
- Materials and resources to include lessons developed by Maryville teachers and software solutions.
- Engaging practice sets with built-in corrective and immediate academic feedback





HOW DOES MY CHILD GET HELP?

- Course teachers are available by email.
- If needed, course teachers are available via zoom for tutoring sessions, when needed.
- Academic Support Center available during the day at the MVS building.
- Tiered Interventions, Special Education and ELL support will be provided.





WHAT IF MY CHILD IS FALLING BEHIND?

- Teachers and administrators will be keeping close tabs on grades and attendance.
- Parents will also monitor grades and attendance through Power School.
- If your child starts to fall behind,
 - Parents will be contacted via phone call or email.
 - Students could be required to Zoom with a teacher for academic intervention or engagement support.
 - Students could be required to come into MVS for in-person sessions for academic intervention or engagement support.



WHEN WILL MY CHILD NEED TO COME IN TO MVS?

- All students will come in for state testing.
- Students will come in for some benchmark or course assessments, based on grade level.
- Students may come in for needed academic or engagement assistance.





WHAT TERMS WILL MY CHILD HAVE AND WHAT ABOUT THE SCHOOL CALENDAR?

- MVS will mirror the schedules of the MCS on-site schools.
 - 2-9.. Yearlong courses
 - 10-12.. Block Scheduling (4 courses each semester)
- We will follow the MCS school calendar.





WHAT COURSES ARE AVAILABLE FOR MY CHILD?

- We are still working on the course catalog for MVS.
- It will be posted on the MVS Website very soon.
- 2-8 Specials provided, including PE, music, and art.
- 9-12 Elective Focus Areas include AP, DE, and CTE.





WHO WILL TEACH MY CHILD?

- 2-8 students will have dedicated virtual teachers who are stationed at the MVS school building.
- 9-12 students will have more subject-specific teachers who are part-time virtual teachers.
- Note: This may be tweaked based on enrollment numbers.





HOW WILL ATTENDANCE BE TAKEN?

- Daily attendance based on productivity, engagement, and assignments (or physical attendance if required).
- MCS and State truancy procedures and laws apply.





WILL I BE GIVEN THE TECHNOLOGY I NEED?

- Students will be issued a laptop.
- WiFi hotspots can be requested, based on financial need.





DOES MVS COST ANYTHING?

- There are no additional charges for the virtual school experience.
- MVS has a flat school fee of \$45 for software and other materials needed.
- Students have a \$40 user fee for laptop usage (You can pay \$20 and request a scholarship for the second half).
- Specialized and personalized elective courses may be available to students to additional fees.





DOES MY CHILD TAKE STATE TESTS?


- Yes, students in grades will take state mandated tests, including TCAPS, high school end of course tests, ACT, etc.
- Students also take grade level benchmark assessments through the school year.





WILL MY CHILD GET A GRADE CARD?

- Parents can always access current student grades and attendance in Power school.
- Grade cards will be sent home each nine-weeks.





WHAT DIPLOMA WILL CHILD RECEIVE?

- MVS students will graduate with a MVS diploma.
- In Maryville, it takes 27 credits to graduate.
- Other graduation criteria will be listed on the MCS website.






CAN MY CHILD JOIN CLUBS AT THEIR ZONED

SCHOOL?

 Students can only join clubs at their current school, which will be MVS.

 Once school gets going, we will survey the students to see what clubs they are interested in having and start to build from there.





WILL THERE BE FILED TRIPS AND EVENTS?


- Field trips will be chosen and planned by the teachers to support grade level curriculum, just like in an on-site school.
- We will have optional school events (which we also ask about in our student survey).





CAN MY CHILD PLAY SPORTS AT MVS?

- Students can play TSSAA sports for their zoned school, if all TSSAA criteria are met.
- Students may be required to sit out a year if they are considered transfer students by TSSAA rules.
- Specific situations need to be emailed to Mrs. Bishop for consultation with the MHS and/or MJHS athletic directors.





CAN I ENROLL OR WITHDRAWAL AT ANYTIME?

- Because jumping from school to school or program to program is difficult on students, we ask for a year-long commitment.
- Transfers out of MVS will require a hardship application and will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- Enrollment is open now.





HOW DO I ENROLL MY CHILD?

NEW STUDENTS—

If you are ready to enroll and are not currently attending a Maryville school, please go to the MCS website and complete the new student registration process.

CURRENT MCS STUDENTS—

If you are ready to enroll now and are currently enrolled in a Maryville school, please go into your school's office and ask to complete a transfer form to MVS.
