In addition to the hotel and air transportation above, the following is also included:

- A. Motor coach transfers between the High School and Philadelphia Area Airport.
- B. Five (5) Disney Dining cards for breakfast, lunch or dinner (four at \$50 each and one for \$10)
- C. One (1) Disney Performance Starter pass which provides four one day per park admission to the Magic Kingdom, EPCOT, Disney's Hollywood Studios or the Animal Kingdom- Based on one performance per discipline (band/choir/orchestra)
- D. All transfers in Orlando between above listed activities utilizing Disney transportation when applicable, also includes any private backstage transfers if needed for performance)

PAYMENT SCHEDULE

CANCELLATION PENALTIES

Any cancellations after 6/1/22 will be charged a \$500 per person penalty.
Any cancellations after 9/1/22 are subject to 100% penalty on total package price.

All transportation, room and board costs are to be paid in full by September 9, 2022. The parents or guardians agree to pay for any property damages caused by their student, including the hotel, student's room, bus, or any other property.

Behavior

Due to the obvious dangers to the student, we insist on the following behavior guidelines:

- Students may not leave our designated activity areas for any reason.
- Association with members of other groups is prohibited.
- Visiting another group's area of the hotel is strictly prohibited.
- Having a visitor from another group is prohibited.
- Show respect to the chaperones and staff at all times. Listening to and following directions of the chaperones and staff will allow the trip to be successful.
- All forms of **alcohol, drugs, and tobacco** products are **prohibited**.
- The schedule that will accompany the final itinerary will be strictly enforced.
- Students are **never** permitted in the room of the opposite sex for any reason.
- Students are expected to behave as they would in school during the trip.
- Your performance off-stage is equally as important as the performance part of the festival and exemplary student behavior is expected.
- School rules will be in effect for the entire duration of this trip. Major violations could result in immediate dismissal from the trip and parents/guardians will be responsible to get your child home immediately if necessary.
- Students are expected to be at all performances. Attendance will be taken.

We hope that this contract will be viewed as a tool to ensure that the environment will be a safe, secure one for all. With your help this experience will be educational, enjoyable and will enhance the positive reputation of the Unionville High School Music Department. 



This letter contains information on how to purchase optional travel insurance for your students high school trip through Travel Insured.

Below is a link that will allow you to purchase the Group Travel Protection Plan for your trip. Rates are based on overall trip cost and not age. You will need to enter your full trip cost for accurate coverage.

- **The “Cancel For Any Reason” option is reflected as an option on the flyer, however the quote/premium on Travel Insured’s website DOES include the “Cancel For Any Reason” option. Please make sure the policy you are trying to purchase is made through the link below to get the student pricing.**
- **DO NOT call to try and book since you may not get the student policy/pricing and your policy will not be linked to the group.**

If interested in purchasing the student discounted travel insurance please click the link below to go direct to Travel Insured. Note: All payments, claims, questions will be done directly through Travel Insured. We are only providing the link if you want to purchase the insurance.

You will be required to provide deposit/payment dates to Travel Insured. These will be the dates you make your payments to the school for deposits/final payment. Please refer to your school advisor on trip due dates for deposits and final payment. Please keep track of all payments made to the school, if a claim is placed later you will need to provide receipts to the insurance company (Example 9/21/22 Ck #275 for \$500).

- Insurance does not need to be purchased until 6/10/2022 as no penalties will be applied prior to the this date. However keep in mind we recommend purchasing by 6/10/2022 since there may be a penalty to cancel after this date. Once the insurance is purchased the premium may be non-refundable. You would need to check with Travel Insured on their policies.
- Travel insurance including CFAR (Cancel For Any Reason) coverage can be purchased BEFORE the families make final payment to the school.
- If you decide to purchase the insurance please list FULL first and last name of traveler as shown on photo ID. (Ex-Suzy Smith; Name on photo ID shows Suzanne Smith; book Suzanne Smith)
- **NO travel insurance can be purchased once final payment has been made to the school. If a family pays their trip in full as example at first deposit they will not be able to purchase the travel insurance.**
