



CHROMEBOOK SELF-INSURANCE PLAN

Students in grades 1 – 12 are provided with an individually assigned Chromebook. Each parent/guardian may purchase an insurance policy provided by the school district. In the event that a parent/student chooses not to purchase the insurance policy, then the parent is 100% financially responsible for the cost of all repairs or replacement.

Option 1 - Self-Insurance Policy – Cost of \$40 annually

1st offense – 50% of cost of repair (up to \$50) or replacement cost whichever is less

2nd offense – 75% of cost of repair or replacement whichever is less

3rd offense – 100% of cost of repair or replacement whichever is less

Lost or stolen – parent/guardian are 100% responsible for cost of replacement

Items that will be covered:

- Accidental damage – i.e., device accidentally dropped, device knocked off desk, etc.
- Liquid damage – i.e., a drink spills near or on your device
- Normal wear and tear

Items that will not be covered:

- Theft – if device is stolen either from home or school
- Lost – if misplaced or cannot find it
- Vandalism or abuse – if blatantly damaged or vandalized devices, ie. carving into the cover, throwing device, misuse of device, removing keys, etc.
- Lost/Damaged Chargers (\$20)

Loaner Pool:

A student will only be issued a loaner if the repair will take longer than 24 hours. Loaners will no longer be available for sign out if a student forgets their device, doesn't charge it, or opted out of having a device all together. If the student damages the loaner, it will be considered the next level offense and the student/parent will be responsible for cost of repair. If the loaner is damaged during the repair process, the student will not be issued another loaner until all costs for repair of the original device and loaner device are paid.

It should be noted that insurance will follow the student, rather than a specific device. If a student has an issue with a device, and they are insured, the insurance will transfer to the "loaner" device. If the issue is covered under warranty, no action or advancement will be needed for insurance purposes. Once repaired, the original device will be returned to the student.

Payment Process:

Payment must be made by September 15th – a deposit of \$20 must be paid before a device is issued to the student. If balance is not paid by September 15th the student will be considered uninsured, 100% responsible for any and all damage to a device, and they will not be refunded the partial payment. There will be no refunds, in the event that a student withdraws from Trigg County Schools.

Approximate repair costs:

Below is a chart of common repairs and associated costs. These are just an estimated cost, as final cost of repairs depend on the amount of damage.

Cracked/damaged screen	\$50.00
Keyboard damage	\$45.00
Lost/Damaged Charger	\$20.00

All other repair costs will be based on materials, availability and labor. Repairs must be paid in full before device will be returned to student.
