Registration

Registration begins online @12:01 a.m. on June 1. Go to the links on our webpage at AvonLibrary.net to register.

The information below will help you pick what reading club is best for adults or which challenges are best for your child. Our website has separate links for adult summer reading and for kid's summer challenges.

Click register and fill out the form. Please include an email address and/or phone number so we can contact you if you win a prize.

For kids ages 0-6, Grades 1-4 and Grades 5-12, the Beanstack application will track reading and activity challenges. **Adults will not be able to track their reading on this platform.**

For adults, reading will be tracked using the READSquared application. Kids in grades 9-12 can also register as a reader using READSquared but must choose between adult & Club 512 (One account only).

Both reading/challenge platforms offer an app to download and use on a smart phone.

Challenges

Logging your reading & completing activity challenges begin June 1@12:01 a.m. and ends on July 22@11:59 p.m. You all challenges by this time. . *No exceptions*! Please count only what you read from June 1 - July 22.

Children ages 0-6 will track their reading by how many books they read or have read to them.

Children in 1st-4th grade will track their reading by number of hours they read.

Both groups will have activity challenges they can complete for virtual badges and prizes.

Kids in 5th-12th grade track their reading <u>by pages only</u> in **Club 512**. For e-books, CD books & audio books, enter the number of pages in the print version <u>OR</u> choose to enter one of the Adult Reading Clubs.

Adults can choose between logging by pages (Cliffhangers) or minutes (Timekeepers). Books in any form count for Cliffhangers. For Timekeepers, books in any form, newspapers, magazines, online blogs - anything you read counts.



PRIZE PICKUP BEGINS JUNE 6

Children's 1st-3rd level prizes, challenge prizes, Club 512 Library Bucks and registration prizes will be given out as earned or you may wait until the end of the program to pick them up all at once. <u>Badges earned are virtual</u>, not physical prizes. Please be aware some children's prizes may run out and won't be replaced, so it is best to pick up your prizes early! All prizes are as supplies last and there may be substitutes. **All prizes must be picked up by July 29.** Raffles for adult readers will be drawn weekly. Raffles for children's reading challenges will be drawn the first week of August and winners will be notified by email or phone.

Turtles Kids who are entering Grades 1-4 this school year	Any child in grades 1-4 who reads on their own or who listens to books read to them by an adult or sibling.	3 levels of prizes @ 2, 4 and 6 hours of logged. Complete 8, 10 and 12 hours for entries into raffle drawings. Virtual badges & additional prizes for activities completed.
Club 512 For teens and tweens only!	Those entering Grades 5-12 this fall Grades 9-12 can choose Club 512 or an Adult Reading Club	Library Bucks earned for every 500 pages read up to 7000 pages. Complete activity challenges toward the total # of pages.
Adult Reading Clubs Timekeepers & Cliffhangers No children/families	Grades 9-12 and Adults age 18 & up	Log reading by 500 pages or 180 minutes read for entry into weekly prize drawings.
