- Addressing the learning needs of students through E-learning while schools were closed with an online learning platform to support students and teachers.
- Professional development for teachers to support efforts for the best possible online and in-person learning.
- Addressing learning loss for all students and for the specific needs of Hispanic/Latino students, Black/African student, Culturally Linguistically Diverse students, homeless students and students with disabilities with tutors, interventionists, and paraeducators.
- Summer programming for students to reduce learning loss
- Coordinating response efforts with the Colorado Department of Public Health to respond to COVID 19 including COVID testing for staff and students, mask mandates, quarantines, health screenings, social distancing, hand washing, etc.
- Providing professional development on sanitizing and cleaning protocols in buildings to minimize the spread of infectious diseases
- Contract disinfecting services for district buildings, additional custodial support, and building repairs and maintenance.
- Continued updating of the district and school websites to provide time sensitive information and resources for parents.
- Contracting with Children’s Hospital to assist schools with the health and safety needs of our students.
- Subscription to “Engage”, an online surveying tool to determine options for our parent community in order to gather information regarding E-learning versus online options for students.
- Increasing the number of counselors in each building to provide mental health services and support students’ social-emotional well-being and development.
- Providing special educators time and support for the increased volume of developing and monitoring IEP Plans.
