

Bay Farm Elementary School- Master Planning Goals

Critical Facility Needs (CFN)

Improvements to meet code requirements, student safety, building infrastructure systems and preservation of buildings from the deleterious impacts of the environment. CFN items are **not** prioritized

- Perimeter fencing for site safety
- Second level fencing to “lock down” inner core of campus buildings after hours
- Revised parking for improved safety during drop off and pick up
- All site walkways that are no longer handicapped accessible.
- Make campus accessible, make it safe, make sure it’s not leaking
- Security and campus drop-off
- Parking improvements to allow safe path of travel
- Fencing and security is High and is priority
- ADA is priority

Educational Program Needs (EPN)

Improvements that impact student learning environments and support the District’s Educational Program/ Education Specifications. EPN improvements impact more than just classrooms and can include libraries, multi-use buildings, student services and outdoor teaching areas. EPN items are prioritized below by committee.

1. New 6-8 classroom building
2. Improve field and site drainage
3. MPR expansion including music classroom and stage
4. New Learning Center building
5. New Science lab
6. Expanded break out spaces
7. Media/ Library addition after science lab
8. Expanded Administration building
9. New Daycare building to remove daycare from MPR

Future Facility Needs (FFN)

Future Facility Needs are improvements not covered above. FFN provides desired improvements that may include aesthetic considerations, optional upgrades or other non-critical but wanted work to each school. FFN items are prioritized below by committee.

1. Playground reconfiguration for basketball striping and expanded blacktop
2. Classroom reconfiguration for inner connectivity between classrooms
