

Franklin Elementary School - Master Planning Goals

Critical Facility Needs (CFN)

Improvements to meet code requirements, student safety, building infrastructure systems and preservation of buildings from the deleterious impacts of the environment. CFN items are **not** prioritized

- Building A Classrooms concrete shear walls appear to have inadequate reinforcement
- Building B Classroom has no seismic gap from adjacent 2 story Classroom Building
- Improve Site security lighting
- Improved perimeter fencing
- Improve power and data infrastructure
- Building accessibility barriers remain
- Mechanical heating and cooling systems are nearing end of service life
- Interior finishes are in need of replacement
- Roofing at end of service life

Educational Program Needs (EPN)

Improvements that impact student learning environments and support the District's Educational Program/ Education Specifications. EPN improvements impact more than just classrooms and can include libraries, multi-use buildings, student services and outdoor teaching areas. EPN items are prioritized below by committee.

1. New Multi-Purpose Building
2. Relocated Admin with Reception fronting on main entrance
3. Renovation of the existing classrooms
4. Robust infrastructure for technology
5. New Break Out (small group meeting) spaces

Future Facility Needs (FFN)

Future Facility Needs are improvements not covered above. FFN provides desired improvements that may include aesthetic considerations, optional upgrades or other non-critical but wanted work to each school. FFN items are prioritized below by committee.

1. (3) additional classrooms
2. Replacement of two story modular classroom building with a new, two story addition to existing classroom wing
3. New play structures
