Registration

STAY ON TRACK FOR GRADUATION!

Any student may be eligible to recover or earn credit for a course. Students in the credit recovery program may complete most assignments either at home (available 24/7 via a computer with internet access) with some additional time at school in a Credit Recovery lab. The online curriculum is highly interactive with audio and video tracks and allows students to move quickly through material previously mastered and focus time on learning more difficult concepts.

Cost: \$0.00 – all fees for Summer School have been waived

When: begins June 6, 2022 and must be completed by June 30, 2022

Where: faculty will be available Monday through Thursday each week:

at Hilton Head High from 8:45 am until 12:45 pm; and
virtually (via Zoom) from 12:45 pm until 3:45 pm.

Rules and Information

- ✓ **Student Tablets** - students who enroll in summer credit recovery course(s) will be allowed to keep their student tablet and return it at the end of the summer session. The terms of the student AUP continue to apply to the use of any tablet through the summer.
- ✓ **Transportation** – bus Transportation to/from Hilton Head High for the morning session (in person) will be provided **upon request**.
- ✓ **Meals** - meals (breakfast & lunch) will be provided for all who attend the morning session (in person).
- ✓ Only students with a final grade of 50 or above are eligible for Credit Recovery unless they receive a Principal waiver. Students with a final average below 50 may request a waiver or must re-take the course to earn credit.
- ✓ To receive credit, students must start and finish the course within the Summer Session. There is no credit given for partially completed courses.
- ✓ Upon successful completion of the Credit Recovery course, a separate grade of “P” will be added to the student’s academic history (transcript) with a notation that the final grade was earned as a result of Credit Recovery. The original failing grade will also remain on the transcript.
- ✓ The NCAA/NAIA has very strict guidelines regarding credit for courses taken online. **Credit Recovery courses offered by the Beaufort County School District are not approved by the NCAA/NAIA.** Students interested in pursuing NCAA/NAIA athletic eligibility must consult with the athletic director and your guidance counselor to determine if the online course that you are considering is approved for credit by the NCAA/NAIA.
