The summer reading and annotation are to be completed for the first day of class. Please read the assigned text closely and keep notes (details below) as you progress through the novel.

It is your responsibility to acquire the assigned text.

- Freshmen (Regular and Honors): Boy 21 (Quick)
- Sophomores (Regular and Honors): Legend (Lu)
- Juniors:
 - *Regular*: What the Eyes Don't See (Hanna-Attisha)
 - *AP*: read both texts
 - What the Eyes Don't See (Hanna-Attisha)
 - Amusing Ourselves to Death (Postman)
- Seniors:
 - *Regular*: The Road (McCarthy)
 - *AP*: A Thousand Splendid Suns (Hosseini)

Annotating the Novel

We recommend that you annotate the novel. The annotation will not be graded but will serve as an invaluable study guide when your teacher assesses you on this work.

- Please read with a pen and take notes in the novel. While you read, use marginal notes to mark key material. Create your own system for marking what is important, interesting, quotable, questionable, and so forth.
- At the end of each chapter or section, *briefly* summarize the material. Also, title the chapter or section to help you remember the specific events/ideas/details in that particular chapter or section.
- Make a list of vocabulary words on a back page or the inside back cover. Defining unfamiliar words will help your understanding of the text.

Be aware that you will be assessed on the reading during the first week of school. Your notes will serve as a good study guide.
