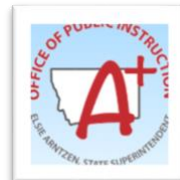

Comprehensive School Community Treatment



- In 2004, a program called Comprehensive School Community Treatment was built with a collaborative effort between Montana DPHHS and Montana OPI. CSCT was designed to operate primarily in the schools with the goal to provide mental health treatment services for youth in their home community, so they would not have to leave their community for residential treatment.
- CSCT Programs are state-wide and operate according to Montana Medicaid rules and requirements.

Eligibility:

- CSCT is open to all students who meet Clinical and Financial Eligibility. CSCT Service must be Medically Necessary for client.
- Clinical: client meets criteria for Serious Emotionally Disturbed-DSM V qualifying diagnosis such as: PTSD, Depression, Anxiety, ODD, etc. along with Functional Impairment.
- Financial eligibility: CSCT is not free. Clients must have a source of reimbursement—Medicaid Insurance pays for daily service. Other Insurances may pay partial benefit. Sliding fees and special considerations are reviewed on a case by case basis.

Referrals:

- Referrals can be made by —school, parent, other agency, physicians, and other treatment centers.
- CSCT is a TIER 3 service in the MTSS structure. Referrals can be made by school Behavior Review Teams

Staff:

- CSCT is a team operation! State CSCT Rule requires a 2 person team consisting of a Licensed Therapist and Mental Health Worker on-site at each school full time.
- CSCT staff receive annual training in crisis response, clinical issues, collaboration skill building with school staff and clients/families.



We Provide For Our Clients K-12:

Psychotherapy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Family Therapy- biweekly• Crisis Response on-site
Psychoeducation- SEL, PBIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Individual• Group• Milieu-school environment

Daily work with CSCT clients across the school environment

- Unstructured time—helping clients generalize skills learned in group, becoming pro-social
- Lunch— psychoeducation or psychotherapy groups
- In-class support for client stability and focus as well as crisis response

CSCT Staff also provide:

- Care Coordination with clients and families, referral to other services
- Consult services with school staff regarding client treatment-formal and informal
- Hours of information sharing, annual staff in-service addressing mental health issues

Some CSCT Rules

- Parental Consent required for client to be in CSCT Program
- Release of Information signed by parent/guardian to give permission for KRBH staff to exchange information with school staff
- Client has Treatment Team that meets every 90 days to update Treatment Plan.
- CSCT program keeps own confidential records secured. We follow HIPAA.

CSCT is not:

- An academic tutoring service
- A Tier 1 drop-in counseling service
- Day Treatment
- A full time 1:1 aide or child care service at school, on field trips, and other activities
