Knowledge and Skills of the Spanish I Curriculum

Communicative Competencies: Students will be able to communicate on the following topics through speaking, reading, listening and writing.

1. Introduce self, including name, age, origin, and birth date.
2. Give and ask for basic information including date, season, weather, time of day and day of the week.
3. Talk about classes/school subjects.
4. Tell about material needs in relation to different school classes.
5. Describe one's personality traits.
6. Talk about activities one likes and doesn't like.
7. Extend, accept or decline invitations.
8. Talk about the foods and drinks one likes and doesn't like.
9. Describe one's eating habits for a typical day.
10. Talk about the structure of one's immediate family.
11. Describe a person's physical appearance.
12. Tell about clothing.
13. Talk about vacation plans, clothing and activities.

Grammatical Competencies: Students will be able to do simple written tasks including the following:

1. Use correct form of adjective in controlled situations. Demonstrate knowledge of noun and adjective agreement.
2. Use correct present tense form of gustar and encantar consistently in controlled situations.
3. Use correct form of present tense regular verbs in controlled situations.
4. Use correct form of common present tense irregular verbs (ir, tener, venir, ser, querer, pensar, poder, estar, ver, etc.) in controlled situations.
5. Tell about obligations using tener + que + infinitive.
6. Tell about plans/things that are going to happen using ir + a + infinitive.
