

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT INIATIVE -SUMMER PROGRAM

As some of you may be aware, BCSD has partnered with local churches and non-profit organizations to provide extended learning opportunities for students in Beaufort County. The Community Engagement Initiative is approaching the next phase of the initiative with a Summer Enrichment Program, north and south of the board. The District is partnering with the churches and non-profit organizations below. **The program will start on June 6th-July 28th, Monday-Thursday, from 10:00 am-2:00 pm.** Transportation will be provided for the students during the month of June but parents will have to transport their students during the month of July. However, Grace Chapel AME will provide transportation for their students during the month of July. School devices will be reissued to the students participating in the program so that they will have access to programs like Reading Plus, i-Ready and IXL in an effort to reinforce the District's educational agenda. The summer programs are expected to focus on reading and math with some recreational time and field trips.
