WHY GO GLOBAL

In today's increasingly global world economy, the GHS International Languages Department has adopted the slogan of "Glacier Goes Global" to support all students in their pursuit of language proficiency, increased cultural competency, and global citizenship. Our slogan embodies the belief that ALL students should be equipped with a global perspective in preparation for their futures.



LANGUAGE COURSES

The International Languages Department currently offers both French and Spanish as language options. GHS students may take each of these languages through level 4 (Spanish 4/French 4 are Advanced Placement/Concurrent Enrollment courses). Students may obtain up to 8 credits though FVCC through the Concurrent Enrollment option.

BECOME PROFICIENT

Students who complete levels 3 and/or 4 of either language may pursue an ACTFL proficiency test during the spring. Students who score Intermediate Mid or higher in all communication modes obtain internationally recognized proof of proficiency that can be used for college level credit/placement, military, and/or career options.

SET YOURSELF APART

International Languages Pathways Distinction acknowledges graduating seniors that complete a plan emphasizing an international language focus in one of two languages. Students must complete four years of one language, maintain a 3.2 GPA in language courses and overall, and complete either a portfolio or two additional years of language.
