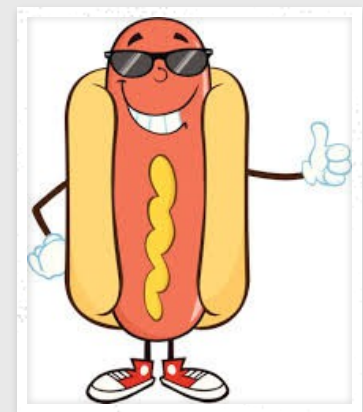

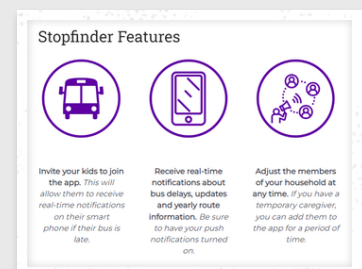
FACILITIES SURVEY OPEN NOW! WE NEED YOUR INPUT!

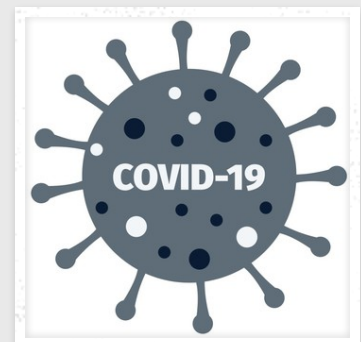
SASD COVID HEALTH & SAFETY PAGE

COVID MESSAGE FROM HEALTH STAFF:
