D. Discussion Items presented by EL Coordinator Ana Martinez

a) EL Coordinator shared Vaughn’s areas of strength and needs for the EL Program. Parents reviewed the 2021 Summative ELPAC results.

- a. *Strengths: Based on the results shared we were able to identify that 12% of our ELs scored at a level 1. 37% of the students scored at level 3. Coordinator shared that students continue to receive explicit ELD instruction during the Designated ELD block. Vaughn has hired additional support personnel (EL Paraprofessionals at each site, 3 additional ELD teachers) to support our ELs and newcomers. Parents shared that the reading programs that students have access to at home are helping their children support them in improving their reading skills.*
- b. *Needs: Based on the data shared we were able to identify that 9% of our ELs scored at a level 4. Coordinator shared that students are not meeting the ELPAC state criteria of receiving a 4 overall in the ELPAC. Parents shared that it would be beneficial for the students to receive tutoring to prepare them for the ELPAC.*
