
Joliet West High School Construction Update

As part of our commitment to construct, operate, maintain and inspect our natural gas system to ensure safe and reliable service to our more than 2.2 million customers, we are making meaningful investments in our natural gas infrastructure which include the expansion of our gas transmission system. Nicor Gas, with its contractor NPL, has been working to expand a portion of our natural gas transmission system located in your community, and we want to keep you informed of a portion of this project which will directly impact the area adjacent to Joliet West High School.

Joliet West High School Area Construction (May-August)

The portion of the project which will directly impact the area adjacent to Joliet West High School will be performed in one continuous phase within the ComEd right-of-way, as outlined in the map below. We anticipate this work to begin the week of Monday, May 30, near the end of this school year, and conclude by the week of Monday, Aug. 1, prior to the beginning of the following school year. During this phase, the parking lot just west of the Joliet West High School football field and surrounding areas will be closed, as outlined in red on the map. **During the construction period, safety fencing will be installed around the entire work zone to ensure the safety of students and residents. It is very important that students do not climb over or cross the temporary safety fencing at any time throughout the project.**

Throughout the duration of the closure, there will be a clear walkway north of the construction zone along Glenwood Avenue to allow students and residents to safely cross the right-of-way on the south side of the street, as outlined in green on the map. Similarly, there will be a clear walkway south of the construction zone along Oneida Street to allow students and residents to safely cross the right-of-way on the north side of the street, as outlined in green on the map. The driveway between the parking lot and the football field will remain open.



Detour signage will be placed throughout the affected areas to guide pedestrian traffic along the alternative routes during the construction period in the area.

We sincerely appreciate your patience as we modernize and improve our natural gas infrastructure. Nicor Gas is working closely with community and school leaders to reduce the impact this work has on student activities and local roads and other pathways.
