Talk Sup Week 9 Review and Preview

November 1, 2020

Good morning Sayreville. I hope you had a pleasant weekend. Please remember that there will be **no remote and/or in-person instruction** <u>tomorrow</u>, <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>November 3</u>, <u>2020</u> due to our staff participating in a full day of inservice workshops, and on <u>Thursday</u> and <u>Friday</u>, so that they can participate in the NJEA Virtual Convention. Naturally, on Wednesday, all students will participate in **remote learning**.

As you know from the broadcast email that I sent last week, this past week we had one reported COVID-19 infection. Since then, I am relieved and pleased to inform you that we have not received any reports to indicate that any of the students and staff who were determined to be in close contact with the individual have tested positive for the virus. As noted above, today is the only day this week that students (preschool, the MD and BD self-contained classrooms, and K-1 Cohort B) will participate in in-person instruction. We will continue with in-person instruction in Phase 2b for students in preschool, the MD and BD self-contained classrooms, and grades K-1 Cohort A & B the Week of November 9th. Unless COVID-19 cases surge to a point that would prohibit it, we will expand in-person instruction for all remaining students the week of November 16th. For childcare purposes and because our elementary schools have already been providing Phase 2b instruction for students in kindergarten and 1st grade, all students in grades 2-3 will return to their elementary schools the week of November 16th in Phase 2<u>b</u>. Thus all kindergarten through 3rd grade students in Cohort B will participate in in-person instruction on Monday, November 16th and Thursday, November 19th while Cohort A does so on Tuesday, November 17th and Friday, November 20th. Conversely, since the Samsel Upper Elementary School (SUES), Sayreville Middle School (SMS), and Sayreville War Memorial High School (SWMHS) have yet perform in-person instruction for a large amount of students, they will begin inperson instruction during the week of November 16th in Phase <u>2a</u>. Thus, 4-12th grade students in Cohort A will attend in-person instruction on Tuesday, November 17th while Cohort B does so on Thursday October 19th. The following week, the grades 4-12 students will join the rest of the district in **Phase 2b**, which we will more than likely remain in until the end of December.
