Last week I had the chance to attend Back to School Night at the Eisenhower Elementary School, Samsel Upper Elementary School, Sayreville Middle School (SMS), and Sayreville War Memorial High School (SWMHS). All were well attended by parents and coordinated exceptionally. In fact, the many parents that I spoke to during them were impressed and appreciative of the information communicated and the



dedication demonstrated by our administrators and faculty. If you were one of the many parents that took the time out of your very busy schedule to attend Back to School Night at your child(ren)'s school, please accept my commendations and sincere gratitude. During Back to School night at SMS last Wednesday, I had the honor of attending the Algebra 1 Parent Workshop presented by Ms. Maharana, Supervisor of Math Instruction, and the Mathematics Department. During this outstanding informational session Ms. Maharana reviewed the pathways in math for graduation. In essence, the session targeted middle school students who are enrolled in Algebra 1 this year and covered how to read a Math PARCC score report, New Jersey Department of Education graduation

Likewise, while attending, the SWMHS Back to School night on Thursday, I dropped by Senior Parent Night, which was presented by Ms. Sicola, Supervisor of Guidance, and the high school counselors. The counselors presented information about the college application process including a senior timeline, financial aid information, and Naviance, the software that our students use to apply online to colleges, and its processes. In addition, information was also shared about the Common and Coalition Apps, the ACT and SAT tests, valuable programs offered at Middlesex County College, and the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Barbara Loftus, Rutgers University Admissions Officer, also presented valuable information about Rutgers, their self-reporting application, essay writing advice, and other tips for the college application process. (HS) 38-0 last Saturday afternoon. The undefeated Bombers improved their season record to 4-0. In addition, the Girls Soccer Team improved its record to 6-3-1 with a tie on Saturday against Colonia HS. Likewise, the Boys Soccer Team evened its record to 5-5 with a big win over Colonia on Saturday. Finally the SWMHS Girls and Boys Cross Country Teams began their seasons last week with impressive wins over Spotswood HS.
