2017-2018 Curriculum & Instruction Goals

- Students in kindergarten and first grade will show improvement in their overall literacy skills.
- Students in grades 6 – 8 will increase their ability to read and comprehend informational text.
- Students in kindergarten through grade 5 will show improvement in their overall mathematic skills.
- Provide at-risk students with a tiered system of supports which includes the Literacy and Math Academies.
- Increase opportunities for all staff to engage in professional development and training sessions related to best practice.
