+ American Rescue Plan

- ARP ESSER (or ESSER III) is authorized under Section 2001 of the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act.
- These funds are to help safely reopen and sustain the safe operation of schools and address the impact of the coronavirus pandemic on the nation's students.
- The \$1.93M in allocated funds may be used for expenses from March 13, 2020 through September 30, 2024.
- Not less than 20% (\$386,000) of the ARP ESSER allocation is to be used to address learning loss through the implementation of evidence-based interventions and ensure that those interventions respond to students' social, emotional, and academic needs.
- Each grant recipient is to seek public comment on its plan for the safe return to in-person instruction, and subsequently post its plan on its website.

+ Return to School Plan

- Keeneyville School District #20 will fully return to school with in person instruction for the 2021-2022 school year.

+ American Rescue Plan Spending

- 30% + will be spent to address learning loss:
 - Summer School
 - Curriculum
 - Social & Emotional Learning
 - Additional technology support
 - Additional student support services
- \$275,000 of local funds will be spent on interventionists to address learning loss
- Remaining allocation to be spent on air quality/HVAC improvements
