Face-to-Face Learning Resumes January 19

Trinity West intends to reopen for 5-day face-to-face learning on **Tuesday, January 19, 2021**. Students will remain in the pathway previously selected unless the parent/guardian contacts Mrs. Ostrosky by **January 11, 2021**. Requests received after this date will not be considered. All requests to change from cyber to face-to-face or face-to-face to cyber are contingent upon space available in the class. All changes will occur on **January 25**, which is the first day of the new semester. School staff will contact those requesting changes prior to that date with more information.

Important Dates to Remember

- January 11 - Final day to make requests to change pathway from in-school learning to cyber
- January 18 - NO SCHOOL (Martin Luther King Day)
- January 19 - Students return to 5 days week in-school learning or cyber learning (same pathway from 10/19)
- January 22 - End of 2nd 9 weeks
- January 25 – 1st day of 2nd Semester (3rd nine weeks)
- January 28 - Report Cards posted on Skyward
