## Fredericksburg City Public Schools

### Preschool Programs

**Dates:** June 5 - June 30

**Days:** Mondays-Thursdays. No classes on Fridays.

**Times:** 8 AM-11:30 AM

**Location:** Walker-Grant Center Preschool

*All eligible students were notified and registered for participation. Specific program details may be obtained by contacting your child's preschool teacher.*

### KinderCamp (rising kindergarten students)

**Dates:** June 13 - July 21

**Days:** 1 week sessions: Monday-Thursday. No classes on Friday.

**Times:** 8:45 AM - 12:45 PM

**Location:** Hugh Mercer Elementary

*Students who are registered for 2022-2023 FCPS kindergarten may participate in a four-day school experience to help them prepare for the transition to kindergarten. Enrollment in KinderCamp is handled through the FCPS registrar at 540.940.8380.*

### Summer School (2021-2022 kindergarten-grade 12 students)

**Dates:** June 6 - July 27

**Days:** Mondays-Thursdays. No classes on Fridays.

**Location:** Kindergarten to grade 5: Hugh Mercer Elementary, 8:45 AM- 12:45 PM  
Grades 6-12: James Monroe High School, 7:45 AM- 12:00 PM

*K-8: Instruction will focus on literacy and math with extension experiences each day such as art, PE, STEAM, and social/emotional support.*

*9-12: Students who did not pass an end-of-course class will participate in remediation necessary to earn credit. Associated SOL tests will be administered.*

### SOL Retakes (2021-2022 grades 8-12)

**Dates:** June 6 - July 27

**Days:** Mondays-Thursdays. No classes on Fridays.

**Location:** James Monroe High School, 7:45 AM- 12:00 PM

*Students who failed the SOL test associated with an end-of course-class, but passed the class will participate in online remediation. They will retake the SOL test.*

### Summer Governor's School

**Program dates and times are shared with students who participate.**

**Location:** James Monroe High School

*Students, who applied and were accepted, participate in a variety of educational experiences focused on real-life application. Higher-level thinking skills and rigorous content are included.*



### Food Service

FCPS students who participate in summer programs will be provided breakfast and lunch each day at school. In some cases, it may be necessary to send lunch home with students.



### Transportation

FCPS students who participate in summer programs will be provided transportation each day. Bus routes will be available on the FCPS website or by contacting your child's school.



### Code of Conduct

Students who participate in summer programs will be expected to follow the FCPS Code of Conduct and attend each day. Failure to do so may result in removal from the program.
