RENT

The Indiana COVID-19 Rental Assistance Program will provide up to \$500 in assistance for four months, totaling a maximum of \$2,000 to eligible renters to help cover past and ongoing rent payments or late fees.

To be eligible, renters must meet the following criteria:

- Lost their job or part of their income due to COVID-19
- Current household income, including unemployment, is less than the household income on March 6
- Have not received rental assistance from another source

Payments will be made directly to landlords and the landlord must agree to participate.

The Hoosiers Hardest Hit Fund program may provide assistance for eligible Indiana homeowners for up to \$30,000. This program helps qualified homeowners make monthly mortgage payments and/or catch up on their payments if they have fallen behind due to a recent involuntary loss of employment or reduction in employment income.
