Program Overview

Health Science I is a nursing certificate program that takes two semesters to complete. The program teaches students basic nursing skills, resident care, and provides practical experiences with residents. Practical resident care procedures taught include: vital signs, bathing, toileting, dressing/feeding residents and bed making. The students will learn 72 basic nursing skills/resident care procedures.

Recommended Qualifications

- A genuine interest in the healthcare field.
- Good communication and social skills.
- Students must have their own reliable transportations to Clinicals which will be held at Springhurst Health Campus located in Greenfield.
- Clinical hours may be held outside of school hours.
- Attendance is mandatory.
- Students are required to stay in the program for the entire school year.
- GPA of a 2.5 or higher is recommended.
- Physical required by the end of the 1st month of school.
