














47th Annual Talent Show

6th, 7th, and 8th Grade Trips

Final payments for the Louisville, Cincinnati, and Washington D.C. trips are due by Friday, March 11th.

To pay for the class trips through eFunds, follow these steps:

1. Log into your Skyward Family Access account.

- 2. Select Fee Management on the left side.
- 3. Select your student from the drop down menu at the top (if you have multiple students).
- 4. Select Make a Payment
- 5. If you are making a chaperone payment, you should see the option to select chaperone payment for the appropriate trip.
- 6. If you are making a payment for your student, select Pay Optionial Fees
- 7. Choose the Fee you want to pay (Cincinnati Student Payment 1 or Louisville Student 2).
- 8. Check to ensure you chose the correct option for your payment.
- 9. Continue with payment process

As a reminder, class trips are considered a privilege. Students with severe disciplinary issues throughout the school year, who are not able to keep an upstanding academic record, or have attendance problems, may be excluded from class trips with the potential for no refund. Good standing checks will be done at the end of each academic quarter.
