School districts that receive Title 1, Part A funds to post on the website of each school serve information on each assessment required by the state to comply with 20 U.S.C. 6311, other assessments required by the state, and assessments required district-wide.

STAAR Grades 5 and 8 Science

STAAR Grades 4 and 7 Writing

STAAR Grade 8 Social Studies

End of Course for English I, II, Algebra I, U.S. History, and Biology

**STAAR** is the state's testing program and is based on state curriculum standards in core subjects including reading, writing, mathematics, science, and social studies. STAAR tests are designed to measure what students are learning in each grade and whether or not they are ready for the next grade. The goal is to ensure that all students receive what they need to be academically successful.
