Our Scheduling Goal: Best Fit for You

Our goal in scheduling is to determine the right fit and right balance of classes for you. We use placement test results, along with data from transcripts and other testing, to schedule you for the course level that best suits you.

Placement Tests Give Us Your Levels

Placement tests are not about getting “all the answers right” or “getting help from others while you take them.” You need to do your own work on the placement tests so that we can get the best indication of your current level of coursework. You do not need to be nervous about the placement testing. You do not need to study for them. Simply get a good night’s sleep the night before.

On Your Testing Day

On your testing day, you will need the following:

- 3 hours of uninterrupted time
- A quiet space to work
- A dedicated computer; it can be a PC or a MAC (placement tests cannot be taken on your phone because the formatting does not translate well)
- Two pencils, sharpened
- Scratch paper
- For Algebra 2 and higher, a calculator with graphing and trig functions
