RETIREE HEALTH BENEFIT CHANGES

Effective October 1, 2012, FUHSD no longer acts as the Billing Agent & Health Benefits Officers for all district health benefits.

CalPERS now acts as the Billing Agent and Health Benefits Officer for all CalPERS medical Benefits for retirees.

The District continues to act in the same capacity for Dental & Vision for retirees and all other employees.

All retirees will receive a letter directly from CalPERS that contains all of the information needed to enroll in health benefits.

What does this really mean?

- All questions (rates, billing, health plans, etc.) should be made directly to CalPERS.
- All enrollments must be done directly through CalPERS.
- CalPERS will deduct the full cost of your health care premiums directly from your monthly CalPERS retirement check.
- FUHSD will send you a check each month for the cost of your **medical** benefits (maximum of \$995.43 pro-rated by your benefit FTE with Dental & Vision costs deducted, if needed).
