Treasury Report: \$14,800

Discussed Family Engagement. Mrs. McBride and Mrs. Lee are working on a punch card for parents who volunteer, whether it be having lunch with your child, attending a family activity like bingo, or donating time in other ways at the school. Punch cards would have 10 punches and 5 punches could earn a legacy brick with the family's name or special quote on it. Marsha Kaveney offered to head up a brick committee to revive the brick program.

Mr. Ayers spoke about student enrollment. 704 students last year, 787 at the start of this year.
-Advisory has been moved to the beginning of the day to ensure that every student has an adult to connect with. After 6 weeks advisory will change with other options for students.
-Discussed traffic flow and drop off/ pick up protocol. There are plans to have a crossing guard monitoring the safety of the students during these times.
