**Things to know...**

**Pack a lunch everyday (a soft sided cooler lunch box with an icepack is preferred)**

**Project Link is a NUT FREE program.**

**Project Link does provide a snack at 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.**

**Send a water bottle every day.**

**Wear closed toed shoes every day.**

**Send sunscreen and bug spray (\*optional) If siblings are in different groups they will need their own set.**

**Be knowledgeable about your child's schedule and field trips.**

**Send an extra set of clothing in case of restroom accidents or messy (mud, paint etc.)**

**Send a backpack daily.**

**Be sure your child has some personal school supplies (crayons, pencils, markers, colored pencils, a book to read)**

**Keep a recess bag in their backpack. Items should fit inside a gallon zip-lock bag. (Good items for recess bags: matchbox cars, action figures, puzzles, coloring/activity book, sticker book, small plastic animals, legos, blocks, dolls etc...)**
