4. Work with the principal and athletic director scheduling performances and securing transportation
5. Perform public relations functions such as developing student interest in instrumental music, cooperating with media, communicating with parents and cooperating with other staff
6. Keep the principal and athletic director informed of developments that would influence the building climate
7. Maximize the safety of all the students
8. Performs other duties as assigned
