QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Five years theatre experience or a degree in theatre, technical theatre or a degree in education with two years experience in tech theatre.
2. Ability to work with people in a creative atmosphere.
3. Ability to repair and maintain the equipment in the theatre.
4. Possess a working knowledge of lightboard, soundboard, pinrail, and other theatrical equipment.
5. Proficiency in the safe use of power tools used in the theatre.
6. Knowledge of theatre scheduling.

REPORTS TO: Theater Manager/Tech Director, High School Principal

JOB GOAL:

To help each participating student achieve a high level of skill, develop an appreciation for the theater, values, and discipline involved in theatrical performances. To provide leadership and direction for students grade 9 through 12. To assist the Technical Director

PERFORMANCE EXPECTATIONS:

The Asst. Tech. Director is expected to support and, at times of absence, act as the Technical Director, with all responsibilities included.

1. Assess and provide for the technical needs of directors, and assist in the development of their production.
2. Schedule and coordinate all theatre usage in conjunction with the high school Activities Director.
3. Instruct the students in the safe use of theatre equipment.
4. Maintain and repair theatre equipment as needed.
5. Maintain a safe and secure environment for the students, technicians, and patrons at the theatre.
6. Serve as a knowledgeable resource to administration, teachers, students, and community representatives who use the theatre.
7. Instruct students in set construction and design, lighting, and sound.
